5. RUNNING OF THE EVENT

There will be 4 qualifying Heats with maximum 5 cars starting abreast in each race over 4 laps.
There will be 5 laps in the Semi-Finals and 6 laps in the Finals.

Heats and Semi-Finals will be driven together. At the end of the Finals, the final results will be split for
the different Championships; points and prizes will be given according to the different regulations.

6. FEES

The entry fee for the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship will be: 200,- €
The entry fee for the Italian Rallycross Championship will be: 300,- € (+ Italian VAT)

A Competitor has to pay ONLY one entry fee:

Zone Competitors entering the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship will score points only for the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship;
Italian Competitors entering the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship will score points only for the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship;
Italian Competitors entering the Italian Rallycross Championship will score points also in the FIA Central European Zone Rallycross Championship;
foreign Competitors (not belonging to the Zone) can enter the Italian Rallycross Championship (prize money);

Start in the Italian Rallycross Championship means follow the national rules concerning use of tyres.

As the entry form from the Driver and the confirmation of the acceptance from the organiser is considered as a contract, the Driver, not coming to the Competition, has to apologise giving the reason as soon as possible.

7. INSURANCE

The entry fee includes Third Party insurance. The Organising Committee stipulates an insurance for Third Party risks as per the conditions laid down in the Italian law and by the ACI-SPORT (Allianz). The original copy of the insurance contract will be available at the event.

8. PROTEST AND APPEALS

8.2 All protests will be lodged in accordance with the Code.

All protests must be made in writing and handed to the clerk of the course or his assistant, or in their absence any of the stewards of the meeting, together with the sum of € 500.

If the protest requires the dismantling and re-assembly of different parts of a car, see ACI-SPORT Yearbook 2017, App.5.

As a summary, protest fees would be as follows:

Cylinder capacity: from € 400 to € 900;

Cylinder head: from € 500 to € 1000;

Complete engine: from € 1000 to €2400 (all fees valid for 4 cylinder engines only);

Transmission from € 450 to € 1350.

Final fee to be set according to ACI-SPORT Yearbook.

9. PRIZES

The Prize Giving for all Divisions will take place in the paddock after results will be official.

The winners of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes must be present.

10. OTHER INFORMATION

10.1 FIRE EXTINGUISHERS

Each Driver is responsible for ensuring that a single piece extinguisher of minimum 5 kg is available within his own team area inside the paddock.

10.2 PROTECTION OF THE ENVIRONMENT

Each driver is requested to ensure that a plastic sheet (minimum dimensions 4 metres by 5) is spread on the ground in the place reserved for his team where work is to be done on his car, in order to prevent any pollution in case of an accidental leak, etc.
